W. S. ジェヴォンズ著作目録・関係文献目録

ウィリアム・スタンレー・ジェヴォンズ (William Stanley Jevons, 1835—1882) は、今日いわゆる近代経済学の創設者、限界革命の担い手の一人としてよく知られている。しかしながら、ヴィクトリア中期の当時においては、彼は論理学者、自然科学研究者およびその解説者、統計学者、さらには社会改良主義者として、より知られた人物であった。彼は、わずか47年弱の期間に、実質的には25年間に、一見すれば無謀とも思えるほど、多数のそれも多方面にわたる業績をあげた。これは、科学、技術がそれまでのアマチュアリズムからしだいにプロフェッショナリズムに支えられながら発展しつつあった19世紀中期の社会的・知的潮流を反映していると同時に、彼の才能の多様性を示すものといえる。

このような論理学、自然科学研究にみられる彼のアマチュアリズムは、彼のプロフェッショナルとしての経済学の形成に大きな役割をはたしてきた。それゆえ、ジェヴォンズ経済学の特徴を明らかにしようとするれば、それら彼のアマチュアリズムのもつ内容を十分理解・評価する必要がある。

このような立場にたったとき、ジェヴォンズの著作目録は、単に経済学上のそれにとどまることなく、彼の経済学を生むのに大きな役割をはたした論理学、科学方法論上の業績はもちろん、彼の自然科学上（化学、気象学、地質学、生理学等）の業績を含む著作目録とならなければならない。しかしながら、ジェヴォンズ自身が最終的に経済学のプロフェッショナルとしての自己の役割に大きな関心をもっていたため、生前に出版された唯一の著作目録“National-ökonomische Schriften von William Stanley Jevons...” 1878〔文献1〕はその表題の示すように経済学上の文献に限定され、この傾向は文献2、4へと受け継がれる。他方、彼の妻が編集した *Letters and Journal of W. Stanley Jevons*, 1884〔文献3〕は自然科学および論理学上の著作を不十分かつ不正確ではあるが含んでおり、“The Australian Writings of William Stanley Jevons” 1949〔文献5〕は、彼のオーストラリア時代に限ってはあるが、彼のほぼ完全な全著作目録となっている。

近年出版された *Papers and Correspondence of William Stanley Jevons*, 1972—81〔文献6〕はその中にいわゆる著作目録（ただし、ジェヴォンズ自からが書き残した著作目

録“List of Writings additional to those included in Appendix B to the *Letters and Journal*, [vol. VII, pp. 121—27] を含む) を含まないが、その第7巻に含まれた索引はかなり著作目録としての役割をもつ。だが、その性質上、不十分なものといわざるを得ない。

以上のような過去の文献を利用しながら、彼の全業績をカバーする著作目録を提供しようとするのが今回のこの試みである。その際、現在のジェヴォンズ研究の水準からみて必要と思われる、彼の業績の翻刻、報道記事、書評、諸外国での翻訳、さらには死亡記事などの文献を可能なかぎり関係文献目録として収録した。また付録として雑誌、新聞を中心とする索引を付した。
