W. S. ジェヴォンズの往復書簡

—ジェヴォンズ著作目録・関係文献目録補遺—

ジェヴォンズ経済学の研究は、*Papers and Correspondence of William Stanley Jevons* (ed. by R. D. Collison Black, volumes 1-7, 1972-1981, London, Macmillan, in association with the Royal Economic Society) の出版によって飛躍的に前進したことは紛れもない事実である（『経済学史学会年報』第22号，1984）。だが，すでに上宮正一郎との共同の書評で「自然科学上のものはともかく，彼の経済学と密接な関係をもつ論理学上の文献についても同様にその公刊を望むことは過ぎるであろうか」と指摘したように，この *Papers* は，彼の多様な業績、とりわけ彼の論理学・自然科学の研究を促進するには多くの問題点を含んでいることもまた確かである。このような *Papers* のもつ弱点を補い，彼の多様な業績に関心をもつ研究者の便宜のために，先にわれわれは「W. S. ジェヴォンズ著作目録・関係文献目録」（『経済学論究』第39巻4号）を作成した。

この目録は，彼の公刊した論文および公開書簡などを含むものの，私的に交換された書簡そのものを含んでいない。本稿は，ジェヴォンズのメンタル・ヒストリーを明らかにする上で極めて重要なこれら書簡の目録であり，この意味で前目録の補遺をなすものである。この書簡目録の作成に際して，まず留意したのは，*Papers* がほとんど収録しなかった彼の論理学・自然科学上の書簡を可能なかぎり収録することであった。さらに，*Papers* 出版後，新たに発見された書簡をもまた可能なかぎり収録した。

現在までに明らかにとなったジェヴォンズによる手紙および彼宛の手紙を所蔵および収録している機関および文献等のうち主なものは，以下の通りである。

これら文献のうち、*Papers* 出版後、新たに発見された書簡の紹介は、文献c（所蔵機関11）および文献g（所蔵機関7）で行なわれている。ただ、後者は、所蔵機関7の所蔵文献2通のうち1通のみを紹介しているにすぎない。また、文献bは、所蔵機関6の所蔵する書簡の年度、枚数、宛て名などを紹介しているが、書簡の日付については記していない。それだけでなく *Papers* には、所蔵機関6および12の所蔵状況はしめされていないため、具体的に所蔵機関6および12の所蔵する書簡は明らかになっていない。それを行なったのが、文献eおよび筆者の確認である。それでもなお、6の所蔵する私的な書簡の具体的な内容は不明のままである。

今後新たにジェヴォンズの書簡が発見されると思われるが、それらを含めてより包括的な書簡集が編集・出版されることが望まれる。ただ、その際の書簡集は、経済学だけでなく、論理学・自然科学、さらには私的な書簡などをも含むべきであろう。
